

Update Your Skills or Learn for Fun with Fall 2017 Seminars or Short Session Classes

The following seminars or short session classes are offered through the School of Business, Technology and Trades to provide many opportunities for updating skills or just for fun! Seminars are graded (unless otherwise noted) on a Pass/Unsatisfactory basis instead of a letter grade, and credits earned are not calculated in the GPA. For most of the seminars, materials are furnished. These courses are offered in two to five sessions, all of which must be attended to receive credit for the course. No make-ups will be allowed. Seminars are one (1) credit unless otherwise noted.

REFUND POLICY: For a refund of tuition, students must drop seminars prior to the first class meeting or within the first two hours of the seminar. Students must complete the drop process by using MYVWCC at www.virginiawestern.edu.

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY RIDER COURSES

This course teaches basic physical and mental skills used in everyday riding. You will be taught basic skills of motorcycle operation, which includes turning, shifting, stopping, and straight-line riding. This course develops skills and street strategies necessary for safe and enjoyable motorcycle operation.

Upon successful completion of this class, eligible participants will receive a **VA DMV** motorcycle operator's license.

Equipment requirements: This basic rider course provides motorcycles. Students are required to wear protective clothing, ¾ or full helmet (Dept. of Transportation approved), eye protection, over the ankle shoes, sturdy full-finger gloves, long sleeve shirt or jacket, and long pants. **Students must be able to ride a bicycle.** Maximum enrollment is 12 people per session.

All classes meet in Business Science Room 245 on Friday from 6:00 - 9:30 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday from 7:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. unless otherwise stated below. Times are approximate and are subject to minor changes due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

RVH classes are NOT eligible for financial aid and CANNOT be audited.

STUDENTS MUST BE ON TIME FOR ALL SESSIONS. LATE ARRIVALS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED.

AWS WELDING SEMINARS

These classes are for experienced welders seeking certification or recertification.

WEL 198 – Recertification (1 Credit)

Provides student with safety review and testing for AWS (American Welding Society) recertification for the following AWS D1.1 Structural Welding certificates: SMAW, FCAW and GTAW. Experienced welders only. Students must wear long pants and closed-toe shoes. Students should bring testing form to class; students will be responsible for submitting recertification form and fee to AWS upon completion of testing. **This class meets at the Greenfield Ed Training Center, 57 South Center Drive in Daleville, VA (Bot. Co.)** This course is not eligible for financial aid.

WEL 298 – Certification (1 Credit)

Provides students with safety review and testing for AWS (American Welding Society) initial certification for the following AWS D1.1 Structural Welding certificates: SMAW (1G, 3G or 4G) - AWS B2.1-1-002-90(R2006) using 3/16 plate; FCAW (1G, 3G or 4G) - AWS B2.1-020-94-AMD1 using 3/8 plate; and GTAW (1G, 3G or 4G) - ANSI/AWS B2.1-1-002-90(R2006) using 3/16 plate. Experienced welders only. Students must wear long pants and closed-toe leather shoes. Students are limited to one exam per class. Cost includes tuition for one credit plus \$50 non-refundable AWS application fee. Financial aid cannot be used to cover the one credit tuition.

This class meets at the Greenfield Ed Training Center, 57 South Center Drive in Daleville, VA (Bot. Co.) This course is not eligible for financial aid.
